ASQUIROGA BAY SHORE PROTECTION TALOFOFO, GUAM

Project Location. Asquiroga Bay is located on the southeast coast of Guam just north of Talofof Bay.

Authorization. The project was authorized under Section 14 of the Flood Control Act of 1946, as amended.

Local Sponsor. The local sponsor is the Government of Guam.

Completed Work. The project consists of a 170-foot long rock revetment protecting a portion of Route 14. The project was completed in December 1985 at a total cost of \$227,181 (federal funds).

Present Status. As a result of Super Typhoon Pongsona in December 2000, damage to the locally constructed betterment consisting of an additional four-foot high revetment was severely damaged. Upon request by the Government of Guam, Department of Public Works, the Corps evaluated the rehabilitation of this project under authority of Public Law 84-99, Flood Control and Coastal Emergencies.

On 4 April 2003, the Honolulu District recommended that the Asquiroga project be repaired as documented in the Project Information Report (PIR). The PIR was approved by our regional headquarters on 2 June 2003. We are currently awaiting funding for the repair work.
