PAGO PAGO AIRPORT SHORE PROTECTION ISLAND OF TUTUILA, AMERICAN SAMOA

Project Location. Pago Pago Airport is located on the southern coast of Tutuila.

Authorization. The project was authorized under Section 14 of the Flood Control Act of 1946.

Local Sponsor. The local sponsor is the American Samoa Government.

Completed Work and Present Status. The first project (Reach A) consists of 2,700 feet of shoreline revetment along the eastern length of the main runway with a crest elevation of 7.5 feet mean sea level. This project was completed in June 1980 at a cost of \$289,080 (federal: \$250,000; nonfederal: \$39,080).

The second shoreline protection project (Reach B) was authorized in February 1981 under Section 14 of the Flood Control Act of 1946. This project consists of a 1,600-foot long rock revetment along the western portion of the main runway to prevent erosion damage and flooding of the airport runway. This second project was completed in June 1984 at a cost of \$175,000 (federal funds).
