WAIANAE SMALL BOAT HARBOR WAIANAE, ISLAND OF OAHU

Project Location. Waianae harbor is located on the west coast of Oahu. Historically, the Waianae waters are popular with the boating public and the nearby fishing grounds are for their productivity.

Authorization. The project was authorized under Section 107 of the River and Harbor Act of 1965.

Local Sponsor. The local sponsor is the State of Hawaii Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation.

Completed Work. The project provides for a main breakwater 1,690 feet long; a stub breakwater 220 feet long; an entrance channel 1,150 feet long, 150 to 180 feet wide and 12 to 15 feet deep; a main access channel 400 feet long, 100 feet wide, and 12 feet deep; and, a turning basin 330 feet long, 200 feet wide and 12 feet deep. The harbor was completed in January 1979 with joint federal and state funds.

Present Status. The cost for the harbor project was \$3,920,686 (federal: \$2,018,020; non-federal: \$1,902,666).
