## INFORMATION PAPER

SUBJECT: F-1 Fuel Pier, Guam

1. Purpose: To provide information on the subject.
2. Points of Major Interest and Facts.
  - a. The proposed plan is to construct a revetment along the shoreline to protect the fuel pier's two petroleum tanks. The study is being conducted under Section 103, River and Harbor Act of 1962 (Public Law 87-874), as amended. The project sponsor is the Port Authority of Guam.
  - b. The F-1 fuel pier is located along a coral outcrop within the commercial port of Apra Harbor. Funds were provided to determine whether there is a Federal interest in pursuing a more detailed feasibility study. The Fact Sheet showing Federal interest was approved by the Pacific Ocean Division on 4 June 2003.
  - c. The Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement (FCSA) and the FCSA-related Project Management Plan are scheduled for completion in early 2004, with the Feasibility Study to follow.
3. Congressional Interest. There is minimal Congressional interest in this project, at this time.
