INFORMATION PAPER

SUBJECT: Apra Small Boat Harbor, Guam

1. Purpose: To provide information on the subject project.
2. Points of Major Interest and Facts.
 - a. The scope of the feasibility study will provide navigational improvements to convert the existing Harbor of Refuge into a commercial and recreational small boat harbor.
 - b. The study is being conducted under Section 107 of the River and Harbor Act of 1960 (Public Law 86-645), as amended.
 - c. At the request of the Port Authority of Guam, the Honolulu District initiated action to secure funding. After receiving funds in January 2002, the Honolulu District initiated a reconnaissance level study to determine whether there is a Federal interest in pursuing a more detailed study.
 - d. Additional site investigations were conducted in early 2003 to determine the physical changes as a result of upper Typhoon Pongsona. A reconnaissance report is scheduled to be completed in late 2003.
3. Congressional Interest. There is minimal Congressional interest in this project, at this time.
