




- a. Sta. 2+00, Unauthorized drainline installed thru the revetment, armor stone not keyed or fitted.





CONDITION OF IMPROVEMENT 30 SEPTEMBER 1989

PREVIOUS PROJECTS: None.

EXISTING PROJECT: Authorized on 12 February 1977 under Section 103a of the River and Harbor Act of 1962, as amended. Provides for revetment totaling, 5,690 feet in length at the following six reaches:

a. Completed Works:

Reach B - 1,000 linear feet along the south side of Niuloa Point, fronting the village of Fatumafuti.

Reach C - 875 linear feet fronting the village of Matuu.

b. Uncompleted Works:

Reach A - approximately 1,050 linear feet along the north side of Niuloa Point, where rock and rubble appear to have been randomly dumped along the shoreline but provide virtually no protection.

Reach D - approximately 560 linear feet fronting the village of Vasaaiga where the existing concrete grouted riprap is undercut and broken.

Reach E - approximately 780 linear feet fronting the village of Faganeanea where the existing concrete grouted riprap is in fair condition with the undercutting at the toe.

Reach F - approximately 1,590 linear feet northeast of the village of Nuuli, where the existing grouted riprap is in good condition with the undercutting at the toe.

PROGRESS OF WORK

Completed and Under Maintenance: Construction of the project is in two phases based on priority of the reaches. Construction completed at Reaches B and C in September 1978.


Work Remaining: Phase II, which includes Reaches A, D, E and F, will be constructed upon availability of federal and non-federal funds.





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
