Corps of Engineers Awards Haleakala Mirror Coating Facility Contract

(HONOLULU – NR 001-06) The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Honolulu District has awarded a contract of \$4,607,000 to San Juan Construction, Inc., for the design and construction of a Mirror Coating Facility at the Maui Space Surveillance Site (MSSS), Haleakala, HI.

The design-build construction of the Mirror Coating Facility will support the Advance Electro-Optical System (AEOS) telescope at the Maui Space Surveillance Site. The constructed two-story facility features a one-story steel frame high-bay building with a standing seam metal roof. Science and technology labs within the facility will also be constructed to support the Air Forces technical staff. Additional storage space for large mirror handling equipment will also be constructed.
