Army Corps Awards Contracts for Multiple Military Installation Renovations

(FORT SHAFTER, HI NR 01-10) The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Honolulu District, recently awarded four contracts for repairs and renovations at three Oahu military locations:

Honolulu District awarded Alutiiq-Mele, LLC., an 8(a) contractor from Honolulu, a \$1,539,810 contract to replace a roof and install two photovoltaic systems on Aliamanu Military Reservation buildings. The 47kw and 37kw photovoltaic systems will harness and convert the sun's rays to create electricity, and help foster a clean, energy independent and efficient infrastructure on Oahu. This is an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funded project.

Honolulu District awarded Wahiawa's Niking Corporation a \$2,726,540 ARRA contract to replace the water-treatment-plant generator at Schofield Barracks, a Multiple Award Task Order Contract project that will help create and maintain jobs in Hawaii.

Honolulu District awarded StarCom Builders, Inc. of Honolulu, a \$528,994 contract to repair exterior drainage at a Schofield Barracks building. This ARRA funded, Multiple Award Task Order Contract project uses federal government resources to stimulate the local economy.

Honolulu District awarded C.W. Crosser Construction, Inc., of Anaheim, Calif., a \$5,769,523 contract to renovate hangar buildings and replace cooling equipment at Hickam Air Force Base, as part of a Multiple Award Task Order Contract for this project.

The Corps of Engineers and the Army in Hawaii are committed to building and facilitating structures that improve service members' community and help the local economy.
