GENERAL SCOPE OF WORK

The work consists of maintenance dredging of specified areas within the Federal limits of the Honolulu Harbor to varied authorized depths of -35 feet MLLW (U5, U6), -40 feet MLLW (U2, U3, U4), and -45 feet MLLW (U7). The dredging will be performed by mechanical clamshell method.

Material to be disposed will be transported via barge directly from the dredged areas in Honolulu Harbor. Disposal method is dependent upon the location the material originates. Disposal will be either to the Environmental Protection Agency's approved South Oahu Ocean Dredged Material Disposal Site or to a permitted upland disposal facility via Kalaeloa Barber's Point Harbor.

PROPOSED SCHEDULE

Healy Tibbitts Builders, Inc. is scheduled to begin maintenance dredging on/about 11 February 2021 in the U3 area (KCT). Work in the entrance channel will require partial channel closure and performed intermittently, in coordination with the State. The proposed project schedule is as follows:
