INFORMATION PAPER

SUBJECT: Kaunakakai Harbor, Island of Molokai, Hawaii

- 1. Purpose: To provide information on the subject project.
- 2. Points of Major Interest and Facts.
- a. Kaunakakai Harbor was authorized by the River and Harbor Act of 1935. The non-Federal Sponsor is the Harbors Division, Department of Transportation, State of Hawaii.
- b. Kaunakakai Harbor is located on the south-central coast of the island of Molokai. The project consists of an entrance channel that is 520 feet wide and 23 feet deep and a basin that is 1,500 feet long, 600 feet wide, and 23 feet deep. The project was completed in 1934 at a Federal cost of \$103,200.
- c. The project was last maintenance dredged in 1973 at a cost of \$240,700, with the removal of approximately 51,000 cubic yards (CY) of material. The dredged material was disposed of at an upland disposal site adjacent to the harbor.
- d. FY19 emergency supplemental funds were received to remove approximately 35,000 CY of sediment that has accumulated within the harbor. Work would be conducted in 2023.
