

Public, Partner, and Stakeholder Review Summary – Guam Draft Watershed Plan

The Guam Draft Watershed Plan was distributed for a 30-day review period on March 1st, 2022 to the Guam Bureau of Statistics and Plans, Guam Environmental Protection Agency, Guam Department of Homeland Security, Guam Department of Public Works, Guam Department of Agriculture, Guam State Historic Preservation Office, Guam Department of Land Management, The University of Guam, Federal Emergency Management Agency, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Guam Division of Aquatic and Wildlife Resources, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Resources. The report was posted online for public access and was sent directly to stakeholders. No Federal Register notice was required.

No written agency and public review comments were received; however, input was gained through meetings and coordination. Meetings were held with partners following the release of the draft report to review recommendations and agency participation. Letters of support were obtained from the following agencies who may have a championing role in implementing recommendations - Environmental Protection Agency, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Guam Bureau of Statistics and Plans, and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.
