Corps of Engineers Awards Two Hickam Contracts

(FORT SHAFTER, HI – NR-13-07) The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Honolulu District has awarded two construction contracts totaling \$24,049,310 for projects at Hickam AFB.

On March 27 a contract for the FY07 C-17 Roads Restoration was awarded to Bivens Electric, Inc. doing business as West Coast Construction in the amount of \$3,097,800. This contract was competed under a small business Section 8(a) Multiple Award Task Order Contract (MATOC). Section 8(a) refers to section 8(a) of the Small Business Act that allows government contracting agencies to Set-Aside procurements to Small Business Act certified 8(a) firms.

On March 31 a contract for the FY07 C-17 Fuel Cell Nose Dock was awarded to Watts Constructors, LLC in the amount of \$20,951,510.

2-2-2 CORPS CONTRACTS

The Roads Restoration contract work involves excavation and replacement of existing pavement, repair of underlying base course, removal and disposal of existing asphalt pavement, removal of fencing, repair of apron parking area, re-striping of apron, landscaping and repair of parking areas. These work areas need to be repaired in order to return Hickam's haul route roads, lay down areas and aircraft parking apron to a usable condition at the conclusion of the major construction projects.

The C-17 Fuel Cell Nose Dock contract entails a creating reinforced concrete foundation, floor slabs on pilings, structural steel frame, masonry walls and roof plus maintenance hangar space, fire protection/suppression system, mechanical areas, storage space, fuel cell air-handling equipment, renewable energy measures, soil remediation, archaeological monitoring, antiterrorism/force protection measures and supporting facilities.
